## **Management of Infectious Diseases in School**

The School Health and Safety Act, Article 19 require children with the following conditions, and children who have been in contact with the following conditions, to be excluded from daycare, kindergarten and school for the periods specified. Please follow the treatment and instructions given by the doctor and once the child has recovered, please submit the "Healing Certificate" below.

	Disease Name	Exclusion Period
Category I	Ebola hemorrhagic fever, Crimean-Congo hemorrhagic fever, smallpox, American hemorrhagic fever, pest, Lassa fever, Marburg disease, polio, diphtheria, severe acute respiratory syndrome (SARS), avian influenza 2019-novel Coronavirus	Until it heals.
Category II	Influenza	5 days after etiology, 3 days after the alleviation of fever.
	Pertussis	After the characteristic cough dissipates, or 5 days treatment with antibacterial prescribed medicine.
	Measles	3days after the alleviation of fever.
	Mumps	5 days after showing up the swellings of parotid glands/submandibular gland/sublingual gland, also after retrieved the good condition.
	Rubella	After all rashes are the alleviated.
	Varicella	After all rashes are covered with scabs.
	Pool fever	2 days after all major symptoms are alleviated.
	Tuberculosis · Meningococcal meningitis	With the Doctor's approval.
Category III	Cholera, shigellosis, enterohemorrhagic Escherichia coli infection, typhoid fever, paratyphoid fever, epidemic keratoconjunctivitis (EKC), acute hemorrhagic conjunctivitis (AHC)	With the Doctor's approval.

※ In addition to the above, for infectious diseases such as mycoplasma pneumonia, streptococcus hemolyticus or hand foot and mouth disease, you are not be able to come to school without the doctor's approval.
